The International Baccalaureate (IB) curriculum we follow at UWC is also highly regarded by the best universities globally and will help open doors to study at the university that is right for you.

Attending one of our schools also gives you access to the largest international scholarship programme for undergraduates in the world. The [Davis-UWC Scholars Program](#) offers scholarships to a large number of US colleges and universities, including all eight Ivy League institutions. Since its inception in 2000, the program has provided scholarships to more than 12,446 UWC scholars from over 165 countries.

Additionally, UWC partners with other leading higher education institutions around the world. In fact, more than half of those that went to university after UWC are attending on a full or partial scholarship.
